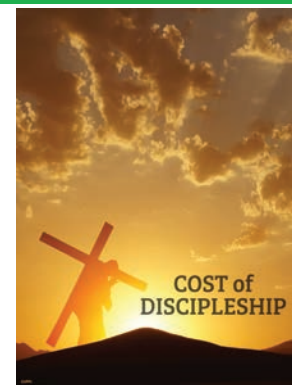

**A NOTE FROM FATHER MIKE**

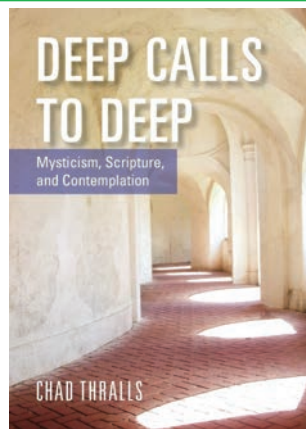

**Archdiocese of Newark - COVID-19 Directives - Updated May 15, 2022**

**STILL IN EFFECT:** Masks will no longer be required for fully vaccinated persons. If not fully vaccinated, persons are strongly encouraged to follow CDC guidance and wear a face mask in public settings. People will no longer be required to socially distance indoors or outdoors, although unvaccinated persons should continue to maintain a safe distance from others. These directives apply to Masses and activities in Church. Archdiocesan protocols for Religious Education and Basketball programs remain in effect.

**LITURGICAL MINISTERS:** All ministries may return to full service – altar servers, lectors, ushers, greeters and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion. Ministers of Holy Communion must still sanitize their hands and wear a mask when distributing Communion.

**COMMUNION:** While Communion on the tongue is now permitted, for the safety of the priests, ministers and other communicants, we encourage continued reception of communion in the hand. At this time, Communion from the cup should not be distributed to the assembly.

**SANITIZING:** The cleaning and sanitizing of churches and common spaces is done regularly. It is not required after every liturgy.

**PARISH MEETINGS:** Parish meetings in person may resume. Those vaccinated are not required to wear masks for indoor meetings nor are they required to maintain social distancing. The same recommendations for Mass apply to those not vaccinated.

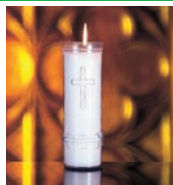

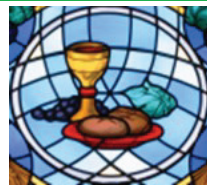

**A Message from the Pastoral Associate John McGuire**  
 Where do we go to learn about our faith? By that, I mean what sources do we use to form ourselves as Catholics, as followers of Jesus Christ. Those of us reading the bulletin, will probably say that we attend the Mass. That is the best start for sure, but it has its limitations.

We of course learn through the Liturgy of the Word, and through the Eucharistic Liturgy. However, the most direct intellectual and spiritual formation that we receive comes from the Homily.

When Father stands before us, to preach, the Institutional Church holds him liable to instruct us on the Catechism of the Church, faith and morals, Holy Scripture, Sacraments, and Catholic Social teaching, as the bare minimum. The average homily will generally last between 5 and 10 minutes. Imagine having to teach the totality of Catholic Faith and Tradition in that time frame. Decisions have to be made. "Do I focus on the Scripture or do I focus on the importance of the Sacraments?" "Should I preach on this grave moral evil, or give the pitch for the Archdiocesan Appeal?"

The reality is that we cannot come out as a fully formed Catholic without seeking Jesus and community outside of Sunday Mass. The lucky thing is that our parish is engaged in many different opportunities to expand our faith life. You can #TryAlpha for a deeper delve into faith as a part of our community. We have a men's prayer group, a Rosary and Altar Society, and various studies. If you have not yet participated yet, look out for Fr. Rob's book discussion group! Additionally, in the coming year, Families of Faith is going to continue the work of creating a community of Faith. We will be grouping families together, so that Parents can grow together in faith alongside their children, engaging the ministries of our parish to help build a stronger community network, and putting a strong emphasis on attending Mass as families.

This week, let us reflect on the opportunities that are available to us, to expand our faith, and grow together in community, and pray for all of our families as their schedules change, and life gets busy once again. Next week we'll be resuming our discussion of stewardship. God Bless and have a wonderful week.
