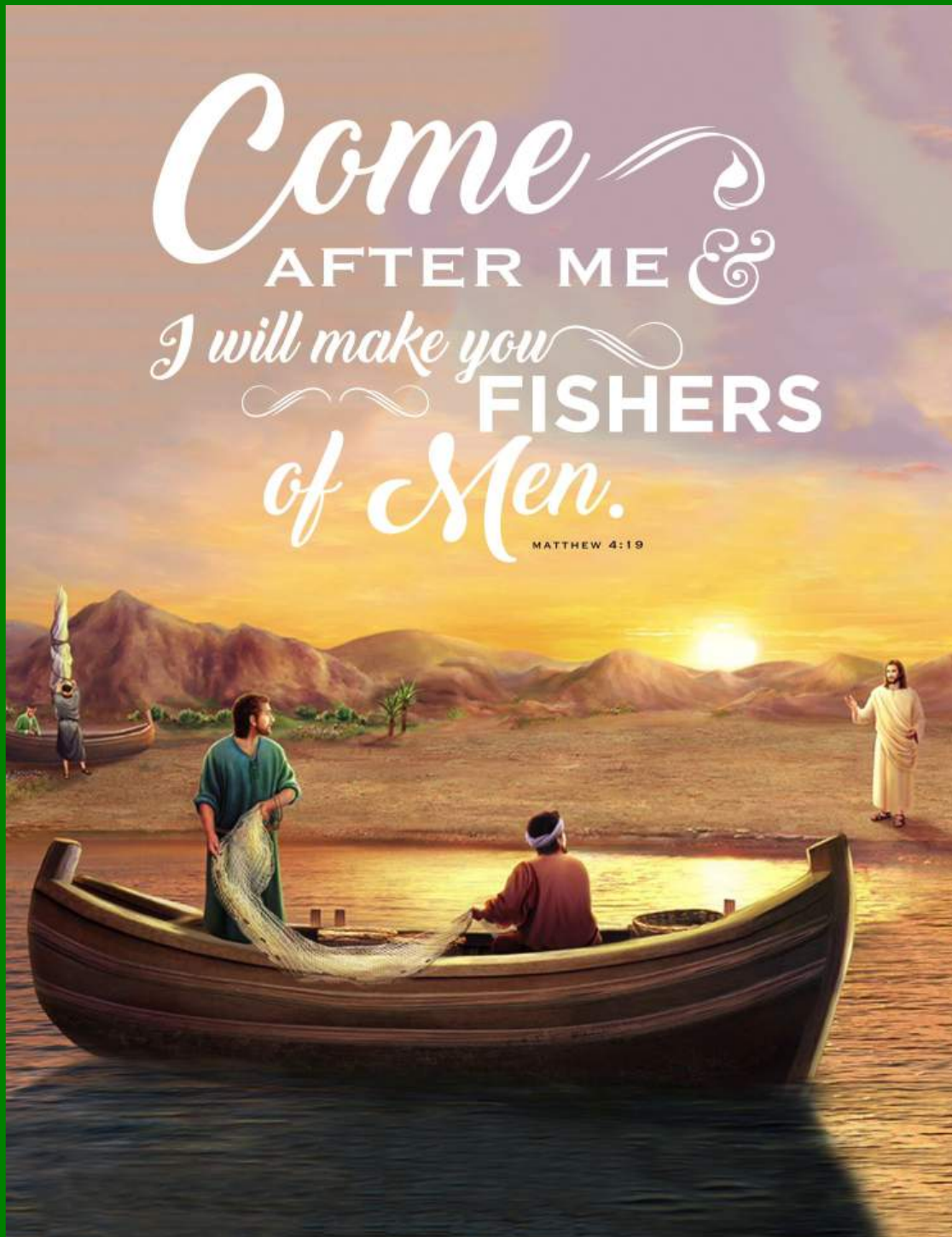

FORMED THE CATHOLIC PATH TO BENEVOLENCE

Archdiocese of Newark - COVID-19 Directives - Updated May 15, 2022

STILL IN EFFECT: Masks will no longer be required for fully vaccinated persons. If not fully vaccinated, persons are strongly encouraged to follow CDC guidance and wear a face mask in public settings. People will no longer be required to socially distance indoors or outdoors, although unvaccinated persons should continue to maintain a safe distance from others. These directives apply to Masses and activities in Church. Archdiocesan protocols for Religious Education and Basketball programs remain in effect.

LITURGICAL MINISTERS: All ministries may return to full service – altar servers, lectors, ushers, greeters and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion. Ministers of Holy Communion must still sanitize their hands and wear a mask when distributing Communion.

COMMUNION: While Communion on the tongue is now permitted, for the safety of the priests, ministers and other communicants, we encourage continued reception of communion in the hand. At this time, Communion from the cup should not be distributed to the assembly.

SANITIZING: The cleaning and sanitizing of churches and common spaces is done regularly. It is not required after every liturgy.

PARISH MEETINGS: Parish meetings in person may resume. Those vaccinated are not required to wear masks for indoor meetings nor are they required to maintain social distancing. The same recommendations for Mass apply to those not vaccinated.

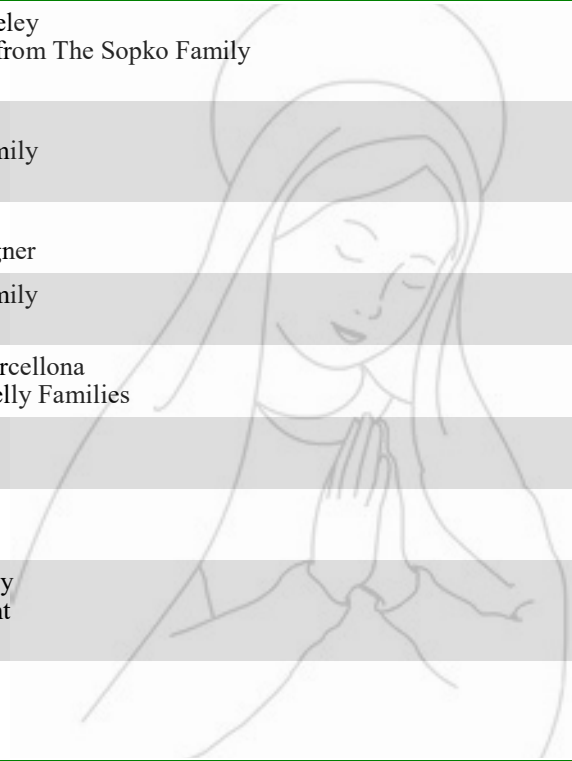

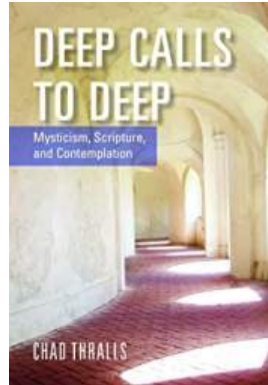

A Message from Faith Formation Pastoral Associate John McGuire:

How can you love someone that you do not really know? We live in a culture that idolizes celebrities. People ingest their social media, articles about them, and watch the movies, concerts, or sporting events that they participate in, and will even claim that they absolutely love and idolize them. The truth is, they don't know square one about that person, because they have often never spoken with them, gotten to know them, or had any substantial interaction with that person. They are interacting with a topic of interest, a brand, or a facsimile of a real person.

In our current culture, we run the risk of having this same relationship with Jesus Christ. I often hear laments from an older generation about the absence of young people in the Church. They used to return to get married, and/or baptize their children, but now that return isn't happening at the same rate. I find myself wondering, how well the younger generation knows Jesus. Families still bring their children for faith formation every year, either for Summer or throughout the year. They are provided with curriculum, and opportunities to gather for formation, service and liturgy, but the truth is that isn't enough.
