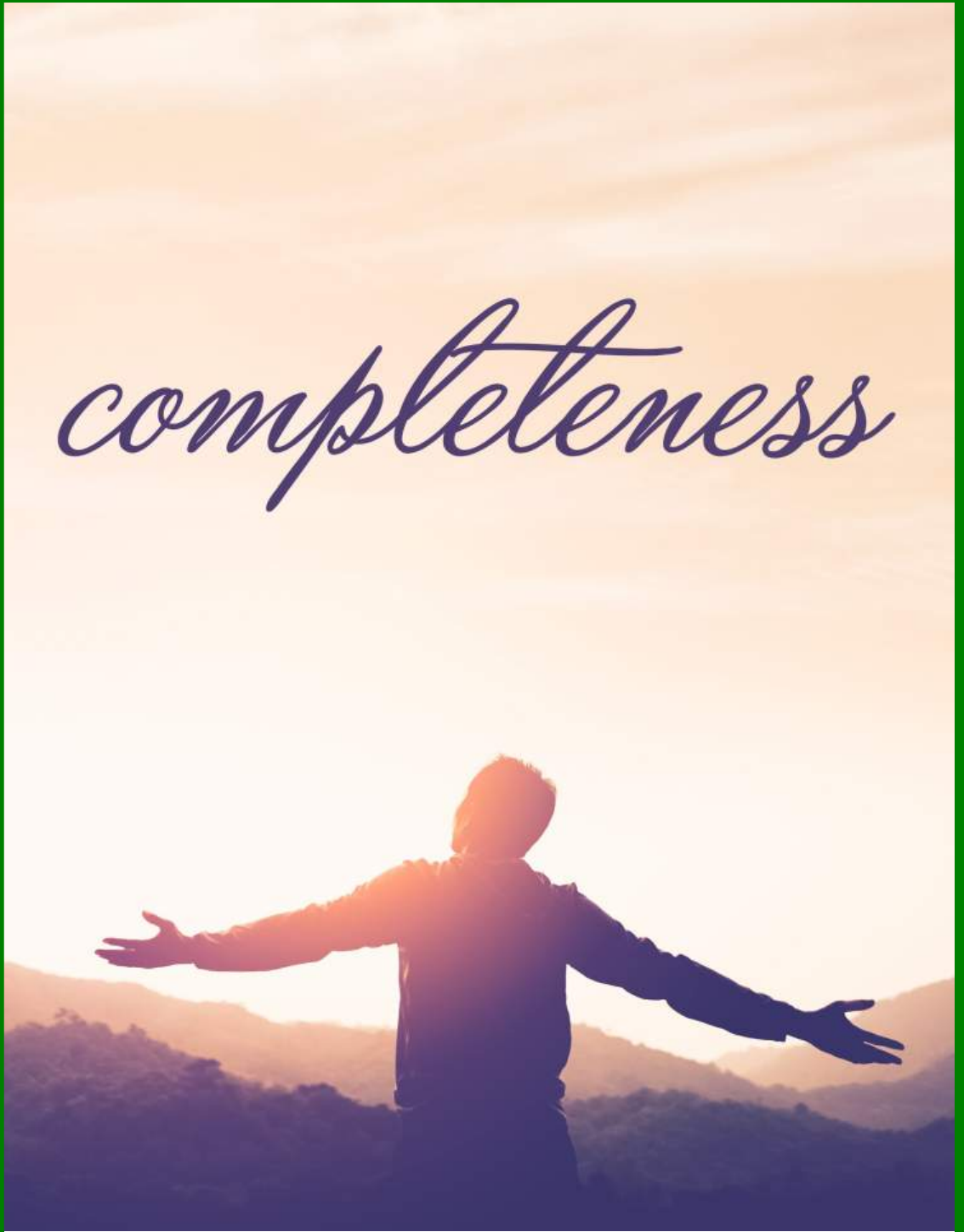

FORMED THE CATHOLIC PATH TO BENEVOLENCE

Archdiocese of Newark - COVID-19 Directives - Updated May 15, 2022

STILL IN EFFECT: Masks will no longer be required for fully vaccinated persons. If not fully vaccinated, persons are strongly encouraged to follow CDC guidance and wear a face mask in public settings. People will no longer be required to socially distance indoors or outdoors, although unvaccinated persons should continue to maintain a safe distance from others. These directives apply to Masses and activities in Church. Archdiocesan protocols for Religious Education and Basketball programs remain in effect.

LITURGICAL MINISTERS: All ministries may return to full service – altar servers, lectors, ushers, greeters and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion. Ministers of Holy Communion must still sanitize their hands and wear a mask when distributing Communion.

COMMUNION: While Communion on the tongue is now permitted, for the safety of the priests, ministers and other communicants, we encourage continued reception of communion in the hand. At this time, Communion from the cup should not be distributed to the assembly.

SANITIZING: The cleaning and sanitizing of churches and common spaces is done regularly. It is not required after every liturgy.

PARISH MEETINGS: Parish meetings in person may resume. Those vaccinated are not required to wear masks for indoor meetings nor are they required to maintain social distancing. The same recommendations for Mass apply to those not vaccinated.

A Message from Faith Formation Pastoral Associate John McGuire:

A long time ago, in a city far away, a soldier was severely injured by a cannonball to the leg. With little left to read he found himself reading the Lives of the Saints. In that condition he found himself discerning between an earthly agenda, to win the hand of a royal, or to dedicate his life to sanctity. In his examination of the options, he found great joy and consolation in devoting himself to the saintly project. That soldier was St. Ignatius of Loyola, the founder of the Society of Jesus (Jesuits) who practices to this day an Ignatian Spirituality.

For the Greater Glory of God, Ad maiorem Dei gloriam in Latin is the order's motto, and perfectly reflects the order's spirituality. A major thrust of the Ignatian Spiritual exercises is to move the brothers and priests to discern God's will above and ahead of all personal attachments and preferences. By detaching personal preference from the process of discernment, they can better follow God's ultimate goal for them. A non-extensive list of characteristics of the Society of Jesus: Union with Jesus, self-awareness, spiritual direction, detachment, love through actions, prayer and efforts of self conquest, finding God in all things, and discernment. Some notable Jesuit saints: St. Ignatius of Loyola, St. Francis Xavier, St. Robert Bellarmine, St. Edmund Campion, St. Peter Claver.
