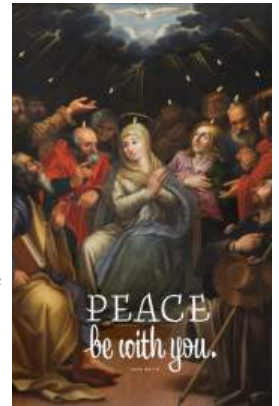

A NOTE FROM FATHER MIKE

The feast of Pentecost began as a celebration of the grain harvest, which had begun at Passover. Later it became a feast of salvation history celebrating the giving of the Law at Sinai and the establishment of Israel as God’s people. These associations were carried over into the Christian feast that marked the conclusion of the Easter season. The harvest and the Law are replaced by the gift of the Spirit, and the first covenant is replaced by the new. The feast of the Law becomes the feast of the Spirit. It is a Spirit that fills us and gives us gifts not for ourselves, but to bring us together in mutual support and love for God and for one another, to love others as Jesus has loved us.

It is that same Spirit that empowered and enabled the Apostles to overcome their fear and anxiety to go out and proclaim the kerygma, the central tenet of our faith, that Jesus is the Christ, He has risen from the dead, He continues to be with us in the Holy Spirit, that we to may experience His victory over sin and death, and continue to proclaim the good news no matter what our situation. 2023 Lenten Regulations

I. The days of both Fast and Abstinence during Lent are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily His Resurrection. The other Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence.

On a day of Fast, only one (1) full meal is permitted, and two (2) smaller meals, which, if added together, would not exceed the main meal in quantity. Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast. On a day of Abstinence, no meat may be eaten. Those who have reached the age of 14 are obliged by the law of abstinence.

II. The obligation to observe the laws of Fast and Abstinence "substantially", or as a whole, is a serious obligation.

III. The Fridays of the year, outside of Lent, are designated as days of penance, but each individual may substitute for the traditional abstinence from meat some other practice of voluntary self-denial as penance.

IV. The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty*) extends from the **First Sunday of Lent, February 26, 2023** to **The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, June 4, 2023**.

Canon 920, §1: All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year.

A Message from Faith Formation Pastoral Associate: John McGuire: A while back we heard the story of the Apostle Thomas. As Jesus appeared to his friends, Thomas wasn't present, so had a hard time believing that the Lord had risen from the dead. To this day, we know him as doubting Thomas, but he did the hard work so that we could believe. This weekend, we commemorate Pentecost. Jesus ascended to heaven, and likely out of fear, the Apostles went back into hiding, in the Upper Room. In an instance, their fear and uncertainty was burned away by the power of the Holy Spirit. Again they had to go through some embarrassment, so that we, who weren't present could believe, and so that the Church could be spread across the world. Today, on Pentecost, I challenge you to share with the children or young people in your lives, an embarrassing moment in your faith. One that made you doubt, fear, or even walk away for a while. Then share with them, how the Father, Son, or Holy Spirit removed the doubt, banished the fear, or drew you back into your faith. Often, culturally we seem to show the young people self assured, holy, clean, never doubting, pious saints. In so doing, we hide or wash away that many of the Psalms express anger with God, that nearly all the Apostles abandoned Christ, and cowered in fear, before fully committing to their sanctity. This Pentecost, let us pray that we, our family, friends, neighbors, and acquaintances who are struggling with fear, embarrassment, struggles, and distance, might experience strength, and God's love to continue our faith journey, and spread the Gospel to the whole world.
