A Message from Faith Formation Pastoral Associate: John McGuire:

What divides human beings from all other terrestrial beings and creations is that we are rational and spiritual beings. Unlike a rock, a tree, or a raccoon, we can know, and question, and experience higher things. When it comes to our faith, we can reflect, search, and reason out so many different aspects of creation and our Creator.

When it comes to certain aspects of faith, we can reflect, but likely won't see the whole picture during this lifetime. Some of those topics include heaven, the Trinity, and the Holy Eucharist. We can continue to study, and reflect on these things, but complete understanding is currently beyond our reach. For thousands of years, for instance, scholars and theologians have attempted to understand and teach the relationship of the Trinity. This task stymied the likes of St. Augustine, and St. Thomas Aquinas. (I won't delve into these, but it is really worth your while to seek out those stories). Then comes the Eucharist. We are taught about Transubstantiation. After the consecration we see bread and wine, yet present in substance, in reality, is the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. In this case, our perception fails us. Yet, our faith, and understanding can embrace the mystery. Rational and spiritual as we are, full understanding of these mysteries of our faith, will evade us, until we have been united in Heavenly Jerusalem. This week, let us pray that we can continue to embrace the beauty and mystery of our faith, until we no longer have to go on faith, but can truly see. God Bless and have a wonderful week.
