A Message from Faith Formation Pastoral Associate: John McGuire

Happy Fathers' Day to all of the men in our parish who dutifully play this important role in the lives of their children, and other young people in their orbit who go without a strong role model. The work we do to mentor and lead the next generation is important, while often underrated.

Want to know how important the role of a father can be in the lives of our children? Just look at the fact that Jesus Christ had two fathers. God the Father, and Joseph his stepfather. I guess that is what it takes to raise the Savior of the World.

We can glean two aspects of fatherhood from this arrangement. God the Father shows us the role of the spiritual father. A man raising his children can have a great deal of influence in the faith lives of their children. While children can grow in faith based solely on their mother's faith, studies have shown that fatherly influence can be a very powerful factor in adoption of lifelong faith.

St. Joseph guided Jesus and Mary to safety as Herrod sought to kill the innocent. Then later in life, went on to teach the Lord life skills and a trade. A father can be a protector and provider for children in a way that is more than financial. Children crave to be cared for and supported by their father.

This week, let us pray for all of our fathers, and father figures both living and deceased, that they may cherish the role that they have been called to, and live up to it, even if they've failed in the past. God Bless and have a wonderful week.
