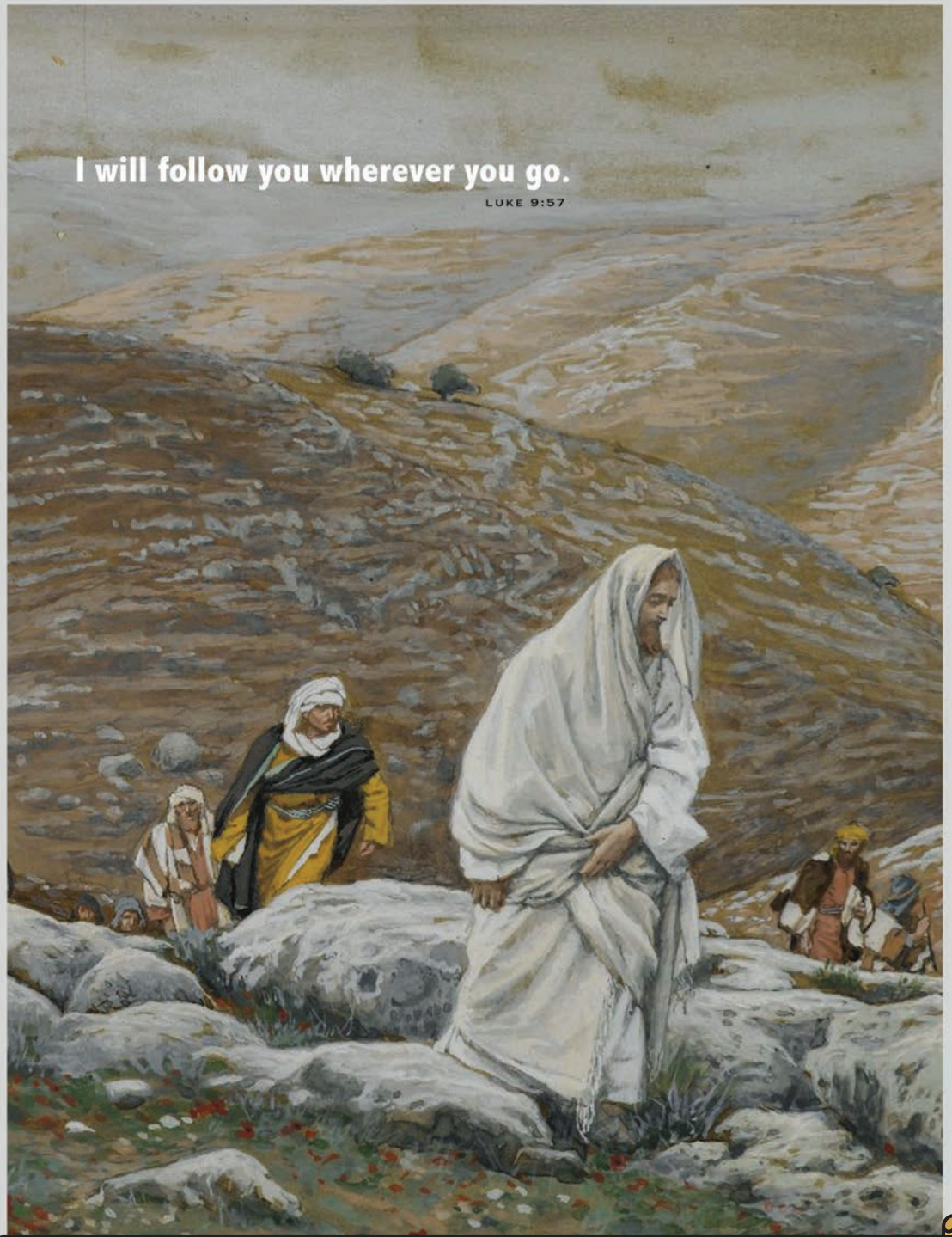

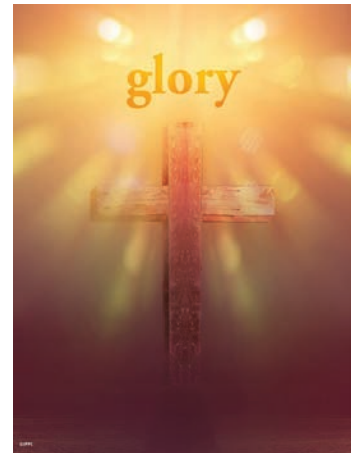

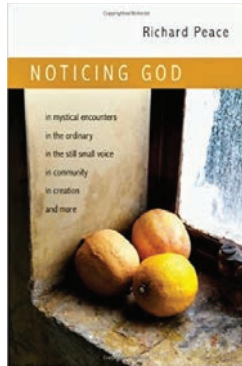

**Summer Spirituality Seminar**

**Archdiocese of Newark - COVID-19 Directives - Updated May 15, 2022**

**STILL IN EFFECT:** Masks will no longer be required for fully vaccinated persons. If not fully vaccinated, persons are strongly encouraged to follow CDC guidance and wear a face mask in public settings. People will no longer be required to socially distance indoors or outdoors, although unvaccinated persons should continue to maintain a safe distance from others. These directives apply to Masses and activities in Church. Archdiocesan protocols for Religious Education and Basketball programs remain in effect.

**LITURGICAL MINISTERS:** All ministries may return to full service – altar servers, lectors, ushers, greeters and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion. Ministers of Holy Communion must still sanitize their hands and wear a mask when distributing Communion.

**COMMUNION:** While Communion on the tongue is now permitted, for the safety of the priests, ministers and other communicants, we encourage continued reception of communion in the hand. At this time, Communion from the cup should not be distributed to the assembly.

**SANITIZING:** The cleaning and sanitizing of churches and common spaces is done regularly. It is not required after every liturgy.

**PARISH MEETINGS:** Parish meetings in person may resume. Those vaccinated are not required to wear masks for indoor meetings nor are they required to maintain social distancing. The same recommendations for Mass apply to those not vaccinated.

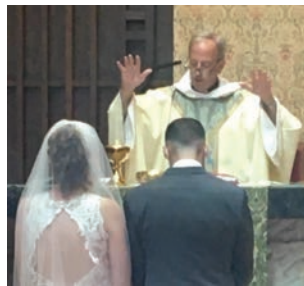

**A Message from Our Faith Formation Pastoral Associate John McGuire**

This last week, I had the opportunity to meet our families participating in our Families of Faith Summer Academy. We met because our summer program begins on Monday, June 27th. I am so happy to be settled in, and begin my work with our families.

There are plenty of reasons that a family might choose to register for a summer program such as Summer Families of Faith. If a student has learning difficulties, there is a great deal of stability and value in a set and consistent schedule. If a family has a difficult schedule with sports and activities, attending over the summer makes a lot of sense. Others like to keep Sunday as a time for family, and would rather spend an hour as a family going to Mass, than bringing their children to weekly classes.

These are all valid reasons to choose such a program. However, I want to take a moment to share with you our parish's mission for offering this. We want to build and nourish a community of Disciples of Jesus Christ. We wish to help our children work through the basics of our faith in an abbreviated period of time, so that we as families can take the time to enter into the true work of our faith.

With this freed up time, we want our families to engage in a robust faith life, family prayer, community worship, the Corporal and Spiritual works of Mercy, and bringing the Gospel out to All the Nations. We do this as a whole community of faith, because Jesus sent the Apostles and Disciples out in teams, not alone.

We will support this by offering community events, service activities, seasonal gatherings throughout the year. Our Summer families are encouraged to attend as many of these as possible! To get started on the right foot, there will be two evening programs for families during each week of Summer Families of Faith. On **Tuesday, June 28th at 6:30 pm**, we'll host a basketball night for the young people. Mr. John McNulty will run them through drills and competitions, the cost for entry will be 1 package of diapers for our diaper drive. We'll be joined by Father Al Tamayo from St. Anthony of Padua Parish in Red Bank, who will tell us about the ministry of Crispin House, and accept our diaper donation. Then, on **Thursday, June 30th, at 7:00 pm**, we'll have a family Mass. All families are invited to join us! This week please pray for the success of our Summer Families of Faith. God Bless and have a wonderful week.
