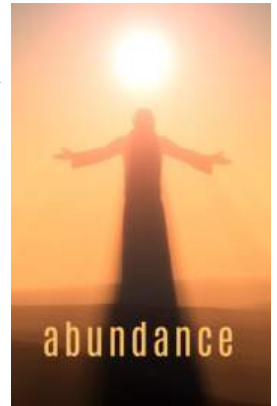

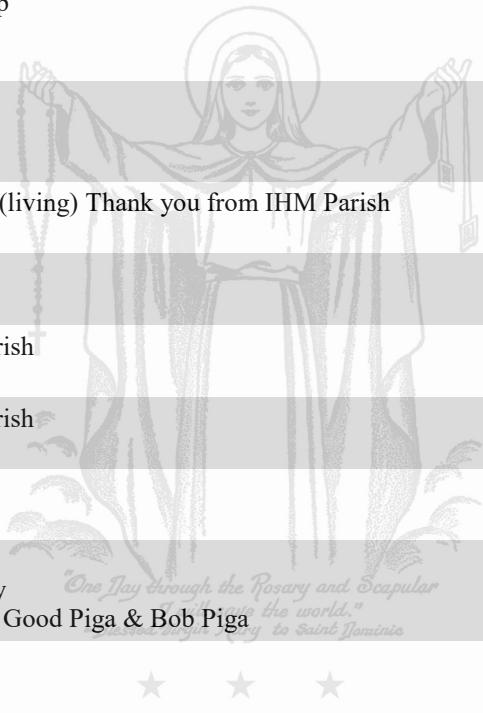



### LADYBUGS: A SIGN OF OUR LADY?

The Enduring Story of How the Insect Earned its Name by Caroline Perkins for Churchpop

Have you heard the enduring story about how the ladybug earned its name? Ladybugs are associated with various symbols, including luck and good fortune. However, did you know there is a symbol from a Catholic perspective? The story goes that in Europe during the Middle Ages, swarms of pesky insects (aphids) destroyed crops and threatened faithful farming communities with starvation. In desperation, the farmers, who had a devotion to the Blessed Mother, turned to the Virgin Mary for help. Soon after, a cloud of black-spotted, red-orange insects came and devoured the pests, saving the crops! The farmers considered this an answer to their prayers and a sign of Our Lady's intercession. They began referring to these life-saving, beautiful as "Our Lady's Bugs". The bug's red-orange wings represent the mantle of the Blessed Virgin Mary, while black spots symbolize her joys and sorrows.

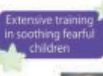
