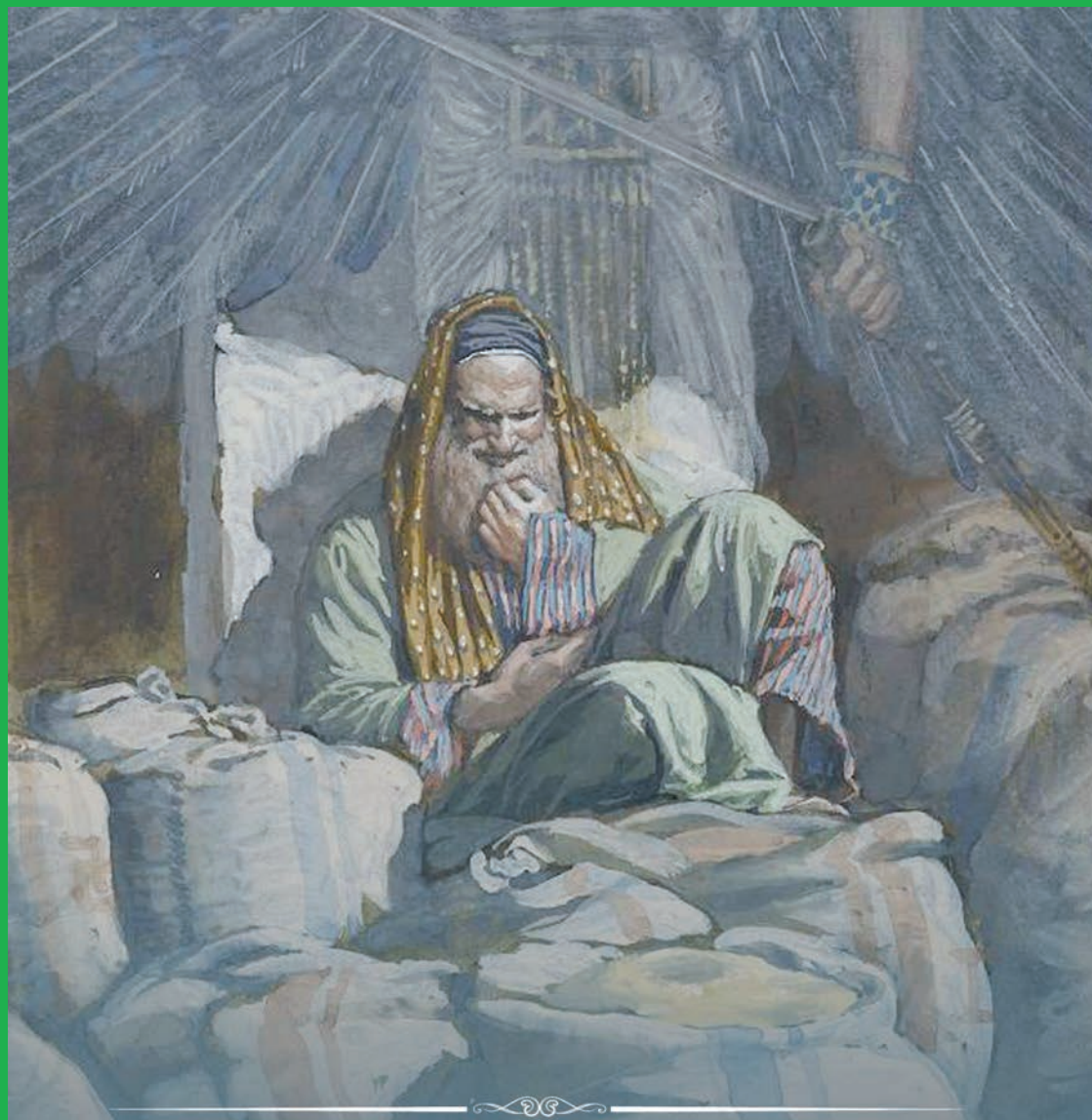

A NOTE FROM FATHER MIKE

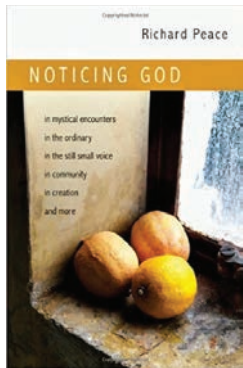

Archdiocese of Newark - COVID-19 Directives - Updated May 15, 2022

STILL IN EFFECT: Masks will no longer be required for fully vaccinated persons. If not fully vaccinated, persons are strongly encouraged to follow CDC guidance and wear a face mask in public settings. People will no longer be required to socially distance indoors or outdoors, although unvaccinated persons should continue to maintain a safe distance from others. These directives apply to Masses and activities in Church. Archdiocesan protocols for Religious Education and Basketball programs remain in effect.

LITURGICAL MINISTERS: All ministries may return to full service – altar servers, lectors, ushers, greeters and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion. Ministers of Holy Communion must still sanitize their hands and wear a mask when distributing Communion.

COMMUNION: While Communion on the tongue is now permitted, for the safety of the priests, ministers and other communicants, we encourage continued reception of communion in the hand. At this time, Communion from the cup should not be distributed to the assembly.

SANITIZING: The cleaning and sanitizing of churches and common spaces is done regularly. It is not required after every liturgy.

PARISH MEETINGS: Parish meetings in person may resume. Those vaccinated are not required to wear masks for indoor meetings nor are they required to maintain social distancing. The same recommendations for Mass apply to those not vaccinated.

A Message from the Pastoral Associate: John McGuire

What do you believe about the Eucharist? Do you believe that when you receive the Bread and/or Wine at Communion, you are receiving the true Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ?

One prominent survey organization, posted a study that suggested that many of us Catholics do not believe in the Real Presence. Since then many priests, and Bishops have repeated this. I will not go into figures and statistics here, or even the methodology of this study. However, I will say that it is hard for me to believe that there are so many Catholics who do not believe, because the Eucharist is such a lynchpin of our faith. If one does not believe, it would seem to follow that they would have by now found one of the numerous, less demanding, and more culturally accepted denominations, and have joined there by now.

As Catholics we do not take the easy path, the path of least resistance, we choose the Way, the Truth, and the Life. We believe that Jesus commanded us to receive Him in the Eucharist every time we gather.

So, as believers, we have to ask how receiving Jesus changes our lives.

What impact does receiving Jesus on a weekly basis make in our lives, and how do we treat those around us? Do we live a more Christlike life? Do we bring what we have received out into the community? Do we encourage friends, family, neighbors, and co-workers to follow Christ, and to treat others with the dignity of an individual created in the image and likeness of our Creator?

These sorts of questions are what the Church will be asking us over the next 3 years, as we all enter into a National Eucharistic Revival. For the first year which began on the Feast of Corpus Christi on June 19th 2022, will focus on Diocesan Revival. Keep your eyes open for opportunities in the Archdiocese of Newark. 2023 will be a year of Parish Revival. Then, in 2024 there will be a National Eucharistic Congress.

This is not going to be a process of philosophical meandering or navel gazing. This whole process will conclude with a year where we as the faithful are to take the revival to its natural conclusion, and bring what we receive out to the whole world in a year of Mission. This week, let us pray for the ability to become what we receive, and teach what we believe.
