


A NOTE FROM FATHER MIKE

Archdiocese of Newark - COVID-19 Directives - Updated May 15, 2022

STILL IN EFFECT: Masks will no longer be required for fully vaccinated persons. If not fully vaccinated, persons are strongly encouraged to follow CDC guidance and wear a face mask in public settings. People will no longer be required to socially distance indoors or outdoors, although unvaccinated persons should continue to maintain a safe distance from others. These directives apply to Masses and activities in Church. Archdiocesan protocols for Religious Education and Basketball programs remain in effect.

LITURGICAL MINISTERS: All ministries may return to full service – altar servers, lectors, ushers, greeters and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion. Ministers of Holy Communion must still sanitize their hands and wear a mask when distributing Communion.

COMMUNION: While Communion on the tongue is now permitted, for the safety of the priests, ministers and other communicants, we encourage continued reception of communion in the hand. At this time, Communion from the cup should not be distributed to the assembly.

SANITIZING: The cleaning and sanitizing of churches and common spaces is done regularly. It is not required after every liturgy.

PARISH MEETINGS: Parish meetings in person may resume. Those vaccinated are not required to wear masks for indoor meetings nor are they required to maintain social distancing. The same recommendations for Mass apply to those not vaccinated.



A Message from the Pastoral Associate John McGuire

92.60% of goal

When we think of Jesus and the Saints, I think we often get a very sanitized picture of who they are. The quiet people with halos who only pray in silence, always follow the rules, and never cause any discomfort, or scandal. When we think this way, we do a great disservice to their memory, and even to ourselves as the faithful. This cleaned up version of Jesus, Mary, and the Saints, can often lead us, and especially the children, to feel bad about our moments of rage, and indignation, even when those are the most reasonable response to a situation.

Jesus did not come to follow the status quo. Jesus came to shake up the status quo, to reform the world, to question injustice, and oh yes to defeat sin and death. He overturned the money changers tables in the Temple, and ultimately stood firm against a death sentence, and so overcame the powers of sin and death. Many great Saints stood up against the wickedness of their times, and even reformed their own religious communities to bring about reform. In many cases these people became estranged from their families, communities, and their own great wealth to bring about the Kingdom of God.

The road to sanctity does not mean that we should retreat to a corner, avoid making a ruckus, or ignoring injustice. It means bringing the truth, especially in the face of great injustices, poverty, and the discrimination of the meek and powerless in society.

This week, let us pray that our families can be empowered to follow Jesus, and the example of the Saints, as we seek to bring about the Kingdom of God, and advocate for those less privileged than ourselves.


