### A NOTE FROM FATHER MIKE

Jesus is not condemning the religious practice of the Pharisee, nor is he condoning the malicious business practices of the tax collector. Rather, he is commenting on their approach to God in their personal prayer. The Pharisee approaches God with a sense of self righteousness, that he is good and is entitled to God's love. The Tax Collector knows that he is a sinful man and does not deserve anything from God. Yet he gives himself over to God's mercy, rather than expecting God's blessing. Jesus reminds his disciples, and us, that the correct way to approach God, and each other, is with humility and reverence, not pride and self righteousness. Yet, how often do we follow in the footsteps of the Pharisee? God wants to show us His love and wants us to experience His presence in our lives. When we think and act in a prideful and self righteous way, towards God and towards one another, we prevent ourselves from experiencing that love and presence in our lives, we risk creating God in our own image and likeness. When we approach God and one another with humility and reverence we open our hearts and minds to the love and presence of Christ in our lives and in others, and are better able to discern how to live out the image and likeness of the God who created us. ### Dear Parishioners and Friends,

We strive to continue our progress in balancing our ordinary income and expenditures as a parish. While our finances have improved there is still some way to go. The Parish Finance Council is working with me to establish a comprehensive funding plan and we will be sharing this with you shortly. We are also in the timeframe when many of you are reviewing your financial goals and strategies for the coming end of the year. Given the time sensitive nature of Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) elections we wanted to at least share this opportunity with you. With that in mind I thought this information might be helpful to some of you and to our parish community:

Those 70 1/2 or older can make a donation from their Traditional IRA without generating any taxable income. Normally any distributions from a Traditional IRA are taxable. This is called a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) and it is especially helpful to those 72 and older who must make required minimum distributions (RMDs) from their Traditional IRA. There are specific tax rules which must be followed when making a QCD. For instance, the transfer must be made directly from the IRA to IHM before year end and the maximum amount that can qualify is \$100,000.

It is suggested that you discuss this strategy with your financial professional to ensure that it is appropriate in your particular circumstances. ### Archdiocese of Newark - COVID-19 Directives - Updated May 15, 2022

STILL IN EFFECT: Masks will no longer be required for fully vaccinated persons. If not fully vaccinated, persons are strongly encouraged to follow CDC guidance and wear a face mask in public settings. People will no longer be required to socially distance indoors or outdoors, although unvaccinated persons should continue to maintain a safe distance from others. These directives apply to Masses and activities in Church. Archdiocesan protocols for Religious Education and Basketball programs remain in effect.

**LITURGICAL MINISTERS:** All ministries may return to full service – altar servers, lectors, ushers, greeters and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion. Ministers of Holy Communion must still sanitize their hands and wear a mask when distributing Communion.

**COMMUNION:** While Communion on the tongue is now permitted, for the safety of the priests, ministers and other communicants, we encourage continued reception of communion in the hand. At this time, Communion from the cup should not be distributed to the assembly.

**SANITIZING:** The cleaning and sanitizing of churches and common spaces is done regularly. It is not required after every liturgy.

**PARISH MEETINGS:** Parish meetings in person may resume. Those vaccinated are not required to wear masks for indoor meetings nor are they required to maintain social distancing. The same recommendations for Mass apply to those not vaccinated.



### A Message from the Pastoral Associate John McGuire

As I have been settling in with the parish, my main focus has been on providing formation, support, and programming for families with children ages kindergarten through 9th grade, and offering programmatic assistance to the high schoolers in youth ministry. This is by default because a parish normally will focus a great deal of its attention on those preparing for sacraments and getting started with their journey.

However, Faith Formation isn't just for growing families. It is a lifelong process that we should engage in throughout our lives. Here at IHM we've got some great opportunities for growth, and for those at different stages of their life. Alpha is great for seekers, and those returning to more active faith. Rosary and Altar Society, Knights of Columbus, and Men's and Women's prayer groups offer a place for those more established in their faith. While these groups are happy to welcome younger members, there is a group, an age level that often does not find its niche within a parish community. Those are members of the faith from say 21-40, who are either young parents, newly married, or single.

Let's face the facts, making adult friends after college, especially in the age of remote work and bar/restaurant closures is difficult, and it is even more challenging to find people of a similar faith and belief system to connect with. I know that my wife and I have felt somewhat isolated as newish parents during Covid-19 with family and friends far-a-field, and that probably isn't a unique situation to be in...


